The By-law Enforcement Activity Report is a report prepared to provide a review of the By-law Enforcement activity for 2023.

### Comments

The report is broken down into main categories including the number of closed cases during 2023.

<b>Yard Maintenance</b> Long Grass, Garbage and Debris, Derelict Vehicles	442
<b>Zoning</b> Use of Land, Recreational Vehicle Storage, Setback	108
<b>Parking</b> Accessible Parking, Blocking Sidewalks	90
<b>Property Standards</b> Unsafe Buildings and Living Conditions	61
<b>Animal Care</b> Animals Not Permitted, Dangerous Dogs	49
<b>Noise</b> Barking Dog, Loud Music	24

<b>Fence</b> Unsafe Fence, Unguarded Pools	13
<b>Signs</b> Prohibited Location, Sight Visibility	8
<b>Miscellaneous</b> Parks Use, Smoking	21
<b>Total Cases Closed</b> Cases Under Investigation	816 45
<b>Total Complaints Received</b>	<b>861</b>

By comparison, By-law Compliance Officers closed 440 cases in 2021 and 682 cases in 2022 which represents an 85% increase in total cases that have been closed in the last 2 years.
