

# **Municipality of Lakeshore**

## **By-law 108-2024**

### **Being a By-law to Authorize the Execution of a Regional Information Technology Mutual Aid Agreement**

**Whereas** section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**And whereas** it is deemed necessary to authorize entering into a Regional Information Technology Mutual Aid Agreement with regional municipal partners, as recommended by the Chief Information Officer at the November 5, 2024 Council meeting;

**Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore enacts as follows:**

1. The Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer are delegated the authority to execute an agreement with the County of Essex, City of Windsor, Municipality of Chatham-Kent, Municipality of Leamington, Town of Amherstburg, Town of Essex, Town of Kingsville, Town of LaSalle, Town of Tecumseh and Township of Pelee, with form and content approved by Legal Services and the Chief Information Officer.
2. The delegated authority described in Section 1 includes the authority to execute any related amendments or agreements in furtherance of this agreement.
3. In the event of a conflict between this by-law and another Lakeshore by-law, this by-law prevails.
4. The delegation in this by-law is subject to any restrictions on such delegation under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 or any other Act.
5. This By-law comes into force and effect upon passage.
