By-law 26-2022

Being a By-law to Repeal By-law 78-2020, Being a By-law to Require the Use of Face Coverings during the COVID-19 Pandemic

Whereas By-law 78-2020, Being a By-law to Require the Use of Face Coverings during the COVID-19 Pandemic, was passed on September 1, 2020;

And whereas By-law 78-2020 is scheduled to remain in effect until such time as the regulation O. Reg. 364/20, *Rules for Areas in Stage 3*, issued pursuant to the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.9, is revoked;

And whereas the Province of Ontario has not repealed O. Reg. 364-20, *Rules for Areas in Stage 3*, but has instead amended the regulation through O. Reg. 213/22 to provide for the removal of masking mandates for certain businesses and organizations;

And whereas the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore desires to repeal By-law 78-2020 to maintain consistency with the Province of Ontario's regulations with respect to face coverings in relation to most publicly accessible premises;

Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore enacts as follows:

1. By-law 78-2020 is repealed.
2. Section 1 of this by-law shall be applied retroactively to March 21, 2022.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon passage.
