By-law 41-2022

Being a By-law to Stop Up, Close and Declare Surplus an Alley on Alley Plan 160, Rochester

Whereas the Municipality of Lakeshore has the authority pursuant to the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, to close, stop up or declare surplus lands that are owned by the Municipality;

And whereas Council deems it desirable to stop up, close and declare surplus an alley, more particularly described as Alley Plan 160, Rochester; Lakeshore, being all of the Property Identifier Number 75036-0124(LT), as recommended by the Division Leader – Civic Affairs at the June 14, 2022 Council meeting;

Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore enacts as follows:

- 1. The land legally described as Alley Plan 160, Rochester; Lakeshore, being all of the Property Identifier Number 75036-0124(LT), identified in Schedule A to this by-law, is permanently stopped up, closed and declared surplus.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute all documents and instruments necessary to implement the intent of this by-law.
- 3. This by-law shall come into force and effect upon registration in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Essex (No. 12).
