Subject: Denis St Pierre Pollution Control Plant Expansion – Project Update

Recommendation

This report is for information only.

Background

The Denis St. Pierre Water Pollution Control Plant (the Plant) was identified to be nearing hydraulic capacity in the Municipality of Lakeshore's Water and Wastewater master Plan Update (completed in May 2018). Further, an Environmental Assessment (EA) for an expansion to the plant was completed in May 2020. Through the EA it was confirmed that the Denis St. Pierre Water Pollution Control Plant Expansion Project would increase the peak operational capacity of the Plant by approximately 70%.

The average flows at the end of 2019, indicated that the Plant was operating at 92% of its rated capacity. Based on this, design of the Plant expansion was initiated.

The Plant expansion includes two (2) projects:

- 1) Treatment Plant: The design of the Treatment Plant expansion was undertaken and completed in June of 2021. The project was tendered for construction in July 2021 and the project was awarded by Council on September 16, 2021, to North America Construction (NAC).
- 2) Plant Outfall The design of the Plant Outfall was undertaken and completed in March of 2022. The project was tendered for construction in March 2022 and the project was awarded by Council on April 26, 2022, to J&J Lepera Infrastructures Inc.

These two (2) projects are required to be completed to commission the Plant.

This report is being presented to provide an update on the projects including schedule and financial status.

Comments

At this time, the Treatment Plant project is progressing generally in line with the baseline schedule provided by the Contractor following award. The project budget tracking for the Treatment Plant is also generally in line with the financial projections as provided by the Consultant for the project.

The Plant Outfall project execution of the agreement for the construction is currently underway. It is anticipated that construction will commence in late July 2022. The construction for the Plant Outfall is required to be substantially complete by March 31, 2023.

The following provides the key milestone dates of the projects:

It is anticipated that the increased capacity of the plant will be able to accept additional connection demand in the Summer of 2023.

An update to this report will be provided in the late fall of 2023 to advise of any impacts and/or changes to the above timelines.
