Municipality of Lakeshore

By-law 98-2022

Being a By-law to Delegate Authority to the Mayor and Clerk to Execute an Agreement for the Provision of Police Services

Whereas pursuant to section 11(2)7 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide;

And whereas section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes Council to delegate its power and duties;

And whereas Council passed resolution #382-11-2022 directing the Corporate Leader – Strategic & Legal Affairs, in consultation with the Corporate Leader – Chief Financial Officer, to negotiate a 4-year contract with the Ontario Provincial Police and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign the agreement, as recommended by the Corporate Leader – Strategic & Legal Affairs at the November 29, 2022 Council meeting;

Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore enacts as follows:

- The Mayor and the Clerk are delegated the authority to execute an agreement with the Ontario Provincial Police with form and content approved by the Corporate Leader – Strategic & Legal Affairs, in consultation with the Corporate Leader – Chief Financial Officer.
- 2. The delegated authority described in section 1 includes the authority to execute any related amendments or agreements in furtherance of this agreement.
- 3. In the event of a conflict between this by-law and another by-law, this by-law prevails.
- 4. The delegation in this by-law is subject to any restrictions on such delegation under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 or any other Act.
- 5. This By-law comes into force and effect upon passage.
