Municipality of Lakeshore

By-law 5-2023

Being a By-law to Amend By-law 98-2020 being a By-law to Delegate Authority to the Mayor and Clerk to Execute an Agreement for the Provision of Police Services

Whereas pursuant to section 11(2)7 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide;

And whereas section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes Council to delegate its power and duties;

And whereas Council passed resolution #382-11-2022 directing the Corporate Leader – Strategic & Legal Affairs, in consultation with the Corporate Leader – Chief Financial Officer, to negotiate a 4-year contract with the Ontario Provincial Police and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign the agreement, as recommended by the Corporate Leader – Strategic & Legal Affairs at the November 29, 2022 Council meeting;

And whereas Council approved By-law 98-2022, Being a By-law to Delegate Authority to the Mayor and Clerk to Execute an Agreement for the Provision of Police Services, to authorize execution of an agreement with the Ontario Provincial Police at the December 13, 2022 Council meeting;

And whereas it is necessary to amend the by-law to authorize execution of an agreement with His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Solicitor General in lieu of the Ontario Provincial Police;

Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 1 of By-law 98-2022 is repealed and replaced with the following:
 - "1. The Mayor and the Clerk are delegated the authority to execute an agreement with the His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Solicitor General with form and content approved by the Corporate Leader Strategic & Legal Affairs, in consultation with the Corporate Leader Chief Financial Officer."
