## By-law 38-2023

## Being a By-law to Authorize an Agreement with the Municipality of Learnington relating to Temporary Fire Chief Shared Services

**Whereas** subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

**And whereas** section 23.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes Council to delegate its powers and duties;

**And whereas** subsection 6(1) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act* mandates the appointment of a fire chief for a fire department and The Corporation of the Municipality of Learnington requires a fire chief for its established fire department;

**And whereas** subsection 2(6) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, authorizes a municipality to enter into agreements with other municipalities to provide and/or receive fire protection services;

**And whereas** Council agrees to temporarily supply fire chief services to The Corporation of the Municipality of Learnington subject to a shared services agreement;

## Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Lakeshore enacts as follows:

- The Mayor and the Clerk are delegated the authority to execute an agreement with the Municipality of Learnington with form and content approved by the Corporate Leader – Strategic & Legal Affairs and Chief Administrative Officer.
- 2. The Chief Administrative Officer is delegated the authority to make decisions regarding the extension of this agreement for an additional term of no more than 5 months.
- 3. The delegated authority described in section 1 includes the authority to execute any related amendments or agreements in furtherance of this agreement.
- 4. In the event of a conflict between this by-law and another Lakeshore by-law, this by-law prevails.
- 5. The delegation in this by-law is subject to any restrictions on such delegation under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 or any other Act.

6. This By-law comes into force and effect upon passage.
